In the gospel of this Sunday, Jesus is trying to open our eyes again, He extends his hand and waits for us to reach for it, to remind us, to make us see once more, that He takes care of our whole life, and that we don't have to worry, but should rejoice, just for the fact that we know Him, that we are Christians, 'citizens of Heaven', as St Paul says.

Today it's also an invitation, to lift our eyes from earthly things, and instead look to heavenly things. To put our trust and faith in the invisible good things.

Do you believe that your Father in heaven has prepared great things for you? That He is willing to give you the true treasure and the true joy?

I invite you to read this gospel with that key, the key of joy, the key of heaven. And to know that the only thing that you are asked is to receive all of these blessings from God, to give Him all your worries and also all your joys so that they can be transformed by him.
